political landscape, with decimation of some parties and enormous growth of others. The current


Parliament (Tweede Kamer) now consists of more unexperienced Members than ever: over 40% of them is brand new and about a third of the remaining group has only a few years of

experience (source). This might shift a bit as soon as a new government is installed, but even four months after the elections it's hard to predict what that government would look like and when that might be. While we're waiting, the Members of Parliament have started their work. S4F thought it fitting to remind them of the fact that it's not just their years in Parliament that count, but that there's a lot

more at stake. There's always been long-term consequences of fixed-term governments and parliaments, but that's the case now more than ever: the consequences of the climate crisis will
