The Coordination Group is a special decentralized group within S4F that oversees the functioning of S4F at the national level. For example, it is responsible for back-office tasks like email handling, setting up National Body meetings and keeping track of ongoing projects. It may also serve as a media contact point. The National Body is informed about the composition of the


